Many opportunities to help with Homeless Connect:

1. Clothes Sorting Days: **Monday Feb. 11 from 9am-3pm, Wednesday Feb. 13 from 9am – 3pm and Friday, Feb. 15th from 9am to 3pm.** Let me know if you are coming so we can plan goodies.
2. **Buy a new sleeping bag:** We were able to get new sleeping bags (thanks to Colleen Squier who noticed the ad and Big 5 who gave us even more of a discount) for \$13.40 each including tax. **“Endow” a sleeping bag or two for \$13.40 each.** The Big 5 store is trying to get us 25 more at an even lower cost. If you need a tax deductible donation slip, we can give that to you.
3. **Knitting hats, scarves, mittens, gloves:** You may knit or you may be part of a knitting group or know of one. We are very short of these items.
4. **Donate any strength readers or your old prescription glasses.** Homeless Connect has a way for some folks to get eye exams and an optical facility that is willing to use old frames and put new optics in them. Box will be on the unit in front of the congregation member photos.
5. **Needed small size shampoo, conditioner, etc.** Another congregation puts together a toiletry kit for each Homeless Connect participant which includes small size shampoos, etc. that you might get at a hotel. The kit is given to each person as they fill out their satisfaction survey at the end of their visit to Homeless Connect. Box will be on the unit in front of the congregation member photos.
