Sermon: Loneliness and the Growth of Fascism

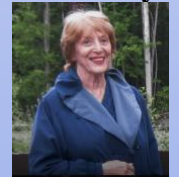

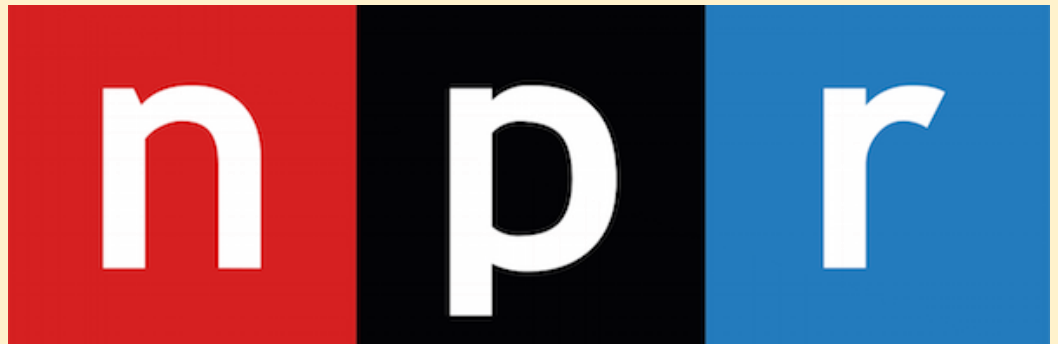


A Conversation with Author Dina Gilio-Whitaker
