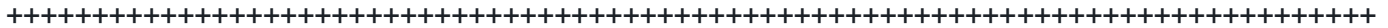

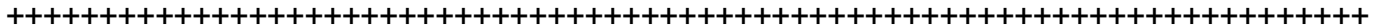
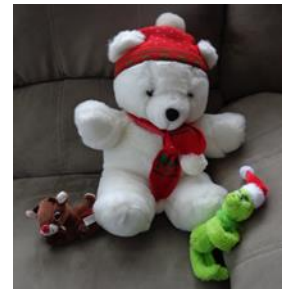


Holiday Gifts for Children in Foster Care

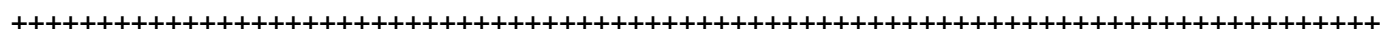

ONGOING EVENTS



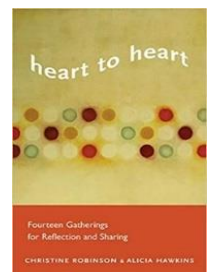
Reflections Women's Group
