The Pacific Northwest District of the Unitarian Universalist Association was officially dissolved Sunday, January 30th. This change has been coming for some time and district leaders have been working hard to ease the transition. The district was founded in 1962 to address the needs of the states in the PNW, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, and Alaska. We will now be a part of the Pacific Western Region, which will be the largest region area wise in the UUA. Two of our PNWD members are on the transition team. After paying any outstanding debts money from the Chalice Lighters Fund (approximately \$26,000) and money from the general fund (approximately \$83,000) will be transferred to the Cascadia Growth Fund serving Washington, Idaho, Oregon, Alaska and British Columbia congregations. The PNWD has been a great support for OUUF over the years. We have received several grants from the Chalice Lighters Fund and been in contact on a regular basis with staff.
