This sermon will address the status of beauty in the scheme of things, using, as a take-off point, a poem by the naturalistic poet, Robinson Jeffers, titled, "The Excesses of God."

Biographical Data on Guest Speaker: Bruce A. Bode is Minister Emeritus at the Quimper Unitarian Universalist Fellowship (QUUF) in Port Townsend, Washington, from which he retired in 2018 as the Senior Minister after serving the congregation for fourteen years (2004-2018).

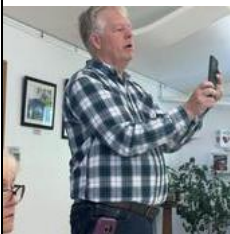
COME ONE, COME ALL!

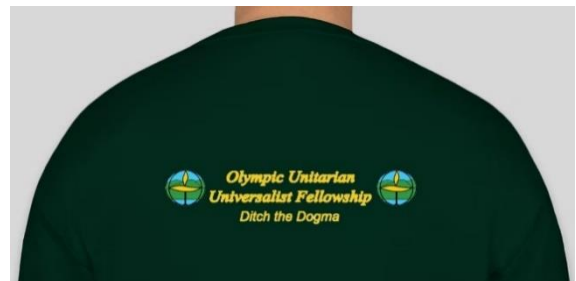
